THIS HAWAII TRIP RULES:

1. Obey all Directors at all times.
2. All Adults are considered CHAPERONES. Obey all chaperones at all times.
3. No smoking or Drinking of Alcohol.
4. Do not leave the room after Curfew or before morning Wake up.
5. Stay in student groups of three or more at all times and do not stray away from the group. All students must be under Adult Supervision at ALL times.
6. Do not damage the Hotel room or any visited facility.
7. No fighting.
8. No offensive touching or inappropriate sexual behavior.
9. No horsing around or making inappropriate comments in the Airports/public places that could be interpreted the wrong way by Airport Officials, Security Officers or any other figure of importance.

If you break any of the above rules you will be sent home with the security officer.

Other General Rules to Follow

1. Do not get in the water if you can't swim.
2. Be very polite and respectful to all people you meet.
3. Do not make racial, derogatory or sarcastic comments. You will encounter many different races of people and many different cultures. RESPECT THIS!! Comments of this nature might get you a GOOD OLE' BUTT WOOPIN' from Retired Military, Active Military, or Visitors/Islanders with no sense of humor.
4. Be very respectful and remember the reason we are visiting Pearl Harbor.
5. Do not cross roads in Waikiki that do not have cross walks.
6. Respect Nature by not harming any ANIMALS, FISH, OCEAN LIFE, PLANTS, FLOWERS, ETC. Please do not litter anywhere.
7. Dress decent at all times. Make sure all swimwear is appropriate and is conservative in taste.
8. Wear sun block at all times. Reapply often if swimming in the ocean.
9. Make sure you rest on the plane or you will be very tired in Hawaii.
10. Drink plenty of fluids and stay hydrated.
11. Be very considerate of others on the plane.
 - a. Be quiet on the plane. This is not a ride to a football game. Many people are traveling on business flights and will be resting.

- b. Do not kick the seat in front of you or rock a lot.
 - c. DO NOT MAKE A BIG SCENE OR BECOME HIGH MAINTENANCE IF THERE IS TURBULENCE, ETC. remain calm or a flight attendant will probably restrain you, turn the plane around, or other normal measures take by the AIRLINE.
12. Do not run or horse play in the rooms or any part of the Hotel.
 13. Never leave belongings unattended. They will get stolen.
 14. Never tell strangers your personal information (name, room number, address, etc.) THERE HAVE BEEN SITUATIONS WHERE GIRLS MEET GUYS, TELL THEM WHERE THEY ARE STAYING, AND A GROUP OF STRANGERS SHOW UP INTENDING TO DO HARM. BE CAUTIOUS AT ALL TIMES.
 15. Never carry valuables on you that are in plain sight. Purse snatching and pick pockets are in every big city around the world.

MAIN BIG RULES:

- BE RESPECTFUL AT ALL TIMES.
- BE ON TIME TO ALL CALL TIMES AND EVENTS.
- DON'T ACT IN A HIGH MAINTENANCE MANNER ON THE PLANE. This is a first flight for many people. Acting in this nature will affect others and will cause Flight Officials to take appropriate measures.
 - MOVE QUICKLY THROUGH AIRPORT LINES.
 - WEAR COMFORTABLE SHOES THAT YOU CAN REMOVE.
- If an Airport Official, Flight Official, or Tour Guide Official requests that you do something, DO IT!!! It is not negotiable.
 - Use common sense at all times.
- Have fun while enjoying and respecting all that is around you.
